7 ERAS OF GOD'S PLAN

- 1. **Harmony**—Genesis 1-2. In God's perfect creation, God the Father is in perfect harmony and relationship with man and woman. All mankind, created in His image, are assigned to be His overseers in charge of all creation.
- 2. **Rebellion**—Genesis 3-11. Tempted by Satan and evil, man, woman and all who succeed them fall into selfish temptation and sin against God and others. Perfect harmony with God, others and nature is broken.
- 3. **Redemption**—Genesis 12-Ruth. God makes a Covenant of Redemption with Abraham and all of Israel, to bless them. Through this covenant the whole world will be blessed.
- 4. **Fallen Kingdoms**—1 Samuel-Malachi. God allows His chosen people of Israel to self-govern with kings like all the other sinful nations. They rise and fall dramatically, but through chosen leaders and prophets He gently calls them to Himself, to follow Him in faith waiting for a new Redeemer King.

7 ERAS OF GOD'S PLAN

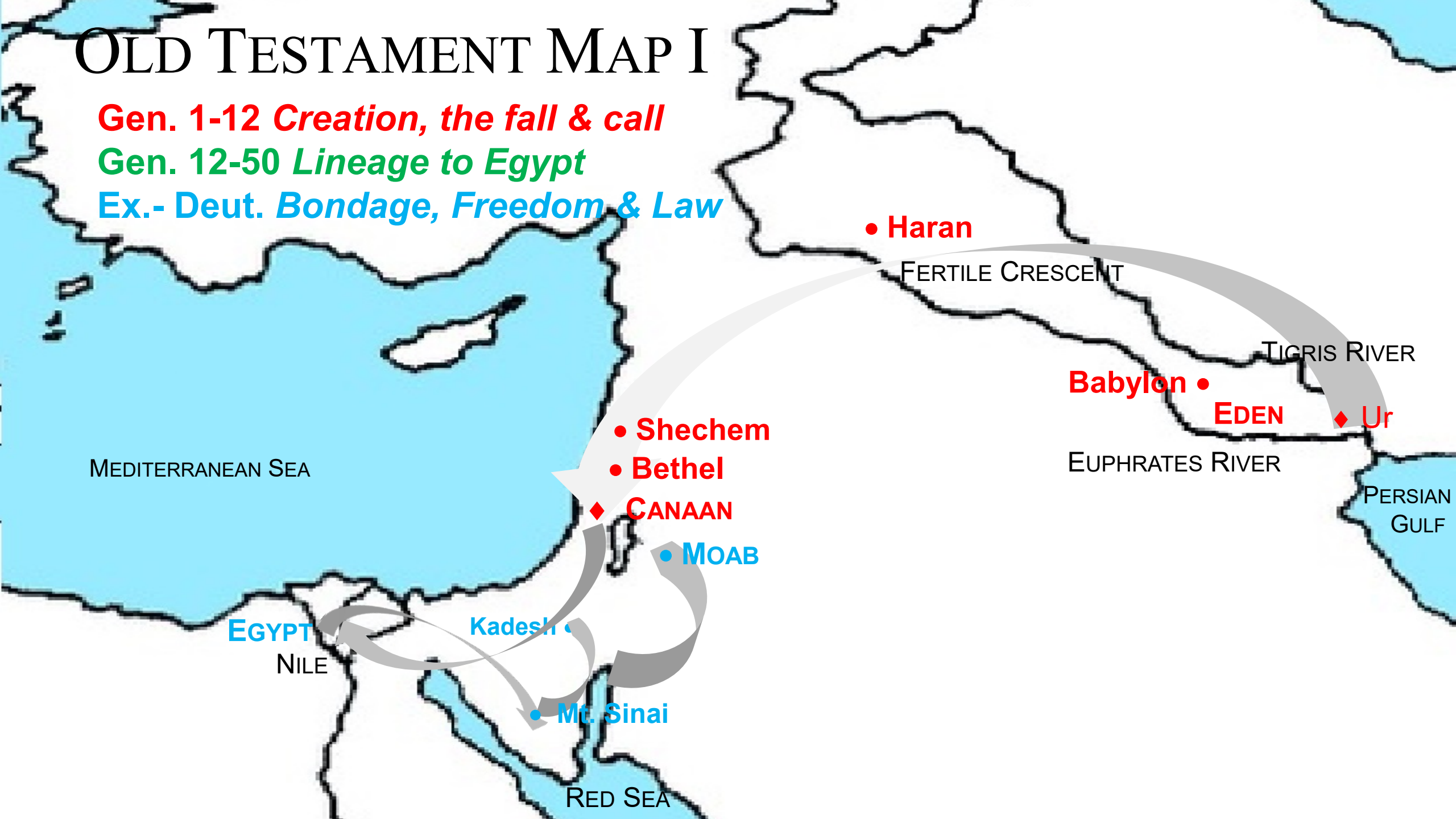
- **5. *The Kingdom of God***—Matthew-John. Christ comes as mankind's Servant and completes His redemptive work on the cross. He acclaims and proves Himself the Son of God, Savior, Messiah, Redeemer, and Resurrected King of Kings.
- **6. *The Church Shares the Gospel***—Acts-Jude. God the Holy Spirit descended at Pentecost, and counsels and guides Christians and His church in all truth throughout the world.
- **7. *Eternal Harmony with God***—Revelation. In God's final story of redemption of His people, Christ gives John and us visions of Christ's return, His final defeat of Satan and all evil on earth, and of glory in Heaven with perfect harmony for us.

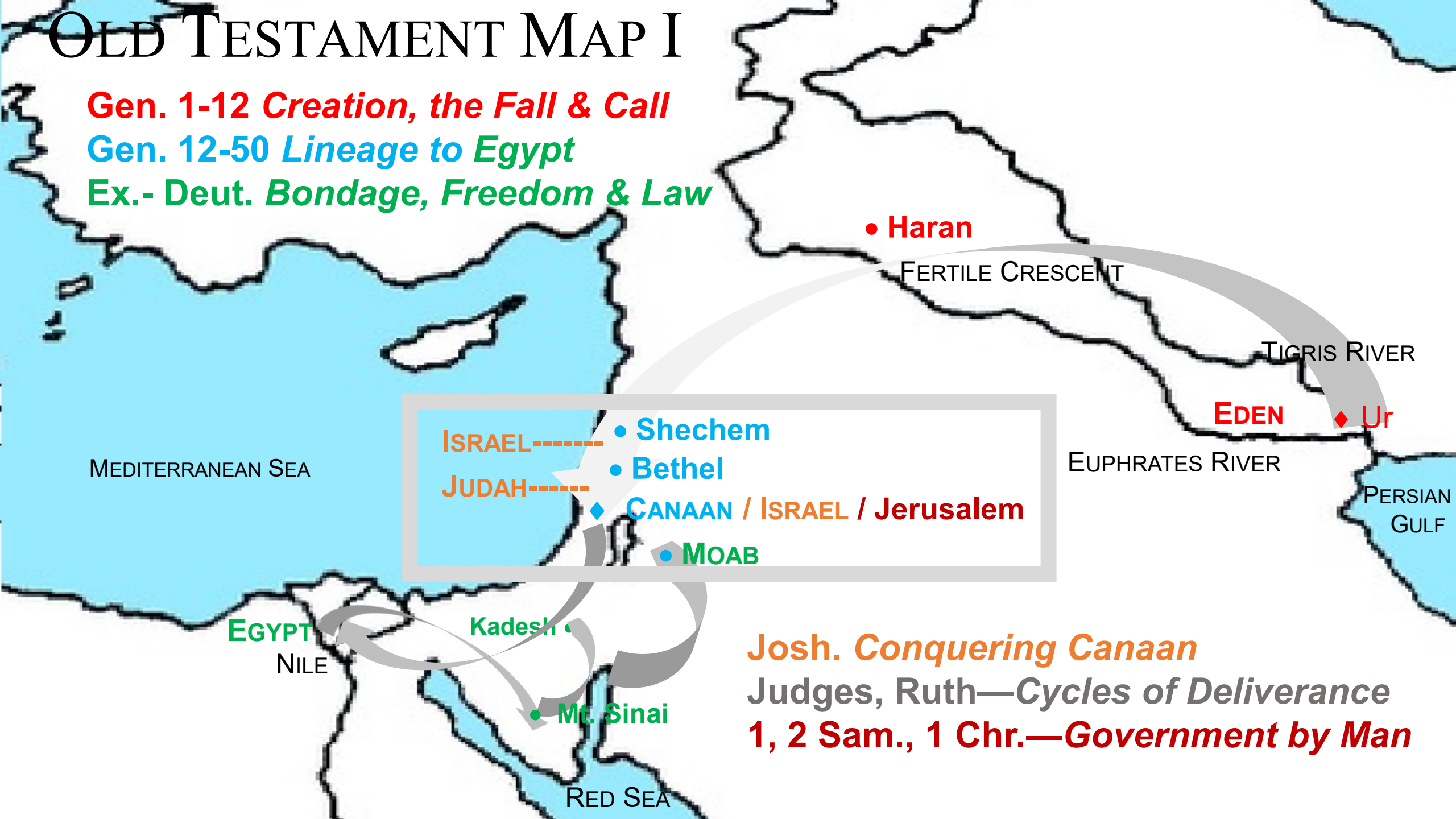

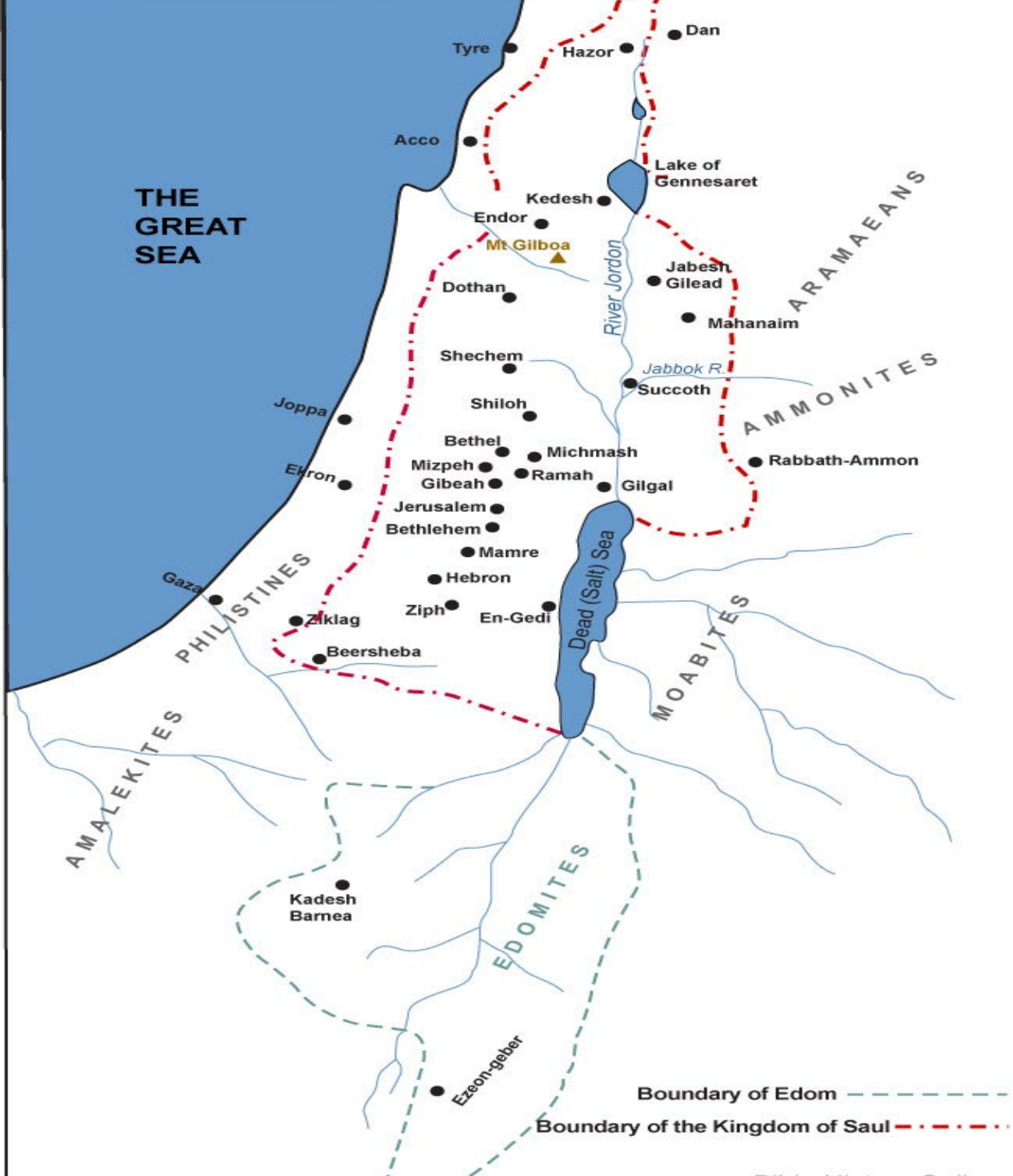

1, 2 Samuel—Governments of God and of Man

- ◆ Samuel is born in 1105 B.C. 1 Sam. 1
- ◆ God called **Samuel** as judge in c. 1067 B.C. 1 Sam. 1-3
- ◆ Israel demanded a king ch. 8
- ◆ **Saul** became king ch. 9-11
- ◆ Saul failed; God picked David ch. 16-17

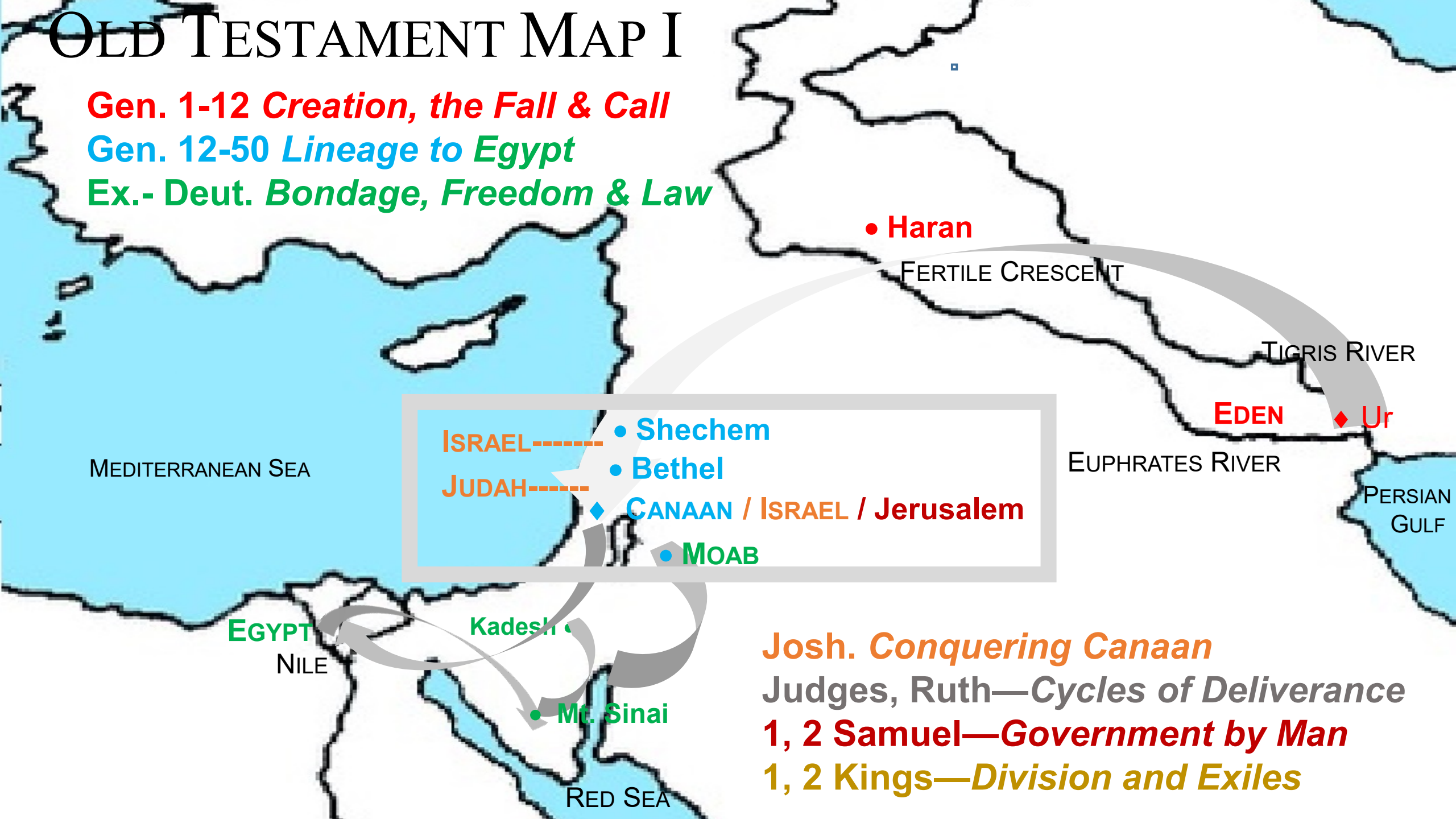
- ◆ **King David *united*** Israel, Jerusalem became worship center 2 Sam. 1-7
- ◆ David defeats Philistia and other nations ch. 8-10
- ◆ David's sins brought trouble and ***division*** to Israel ch. 11-24

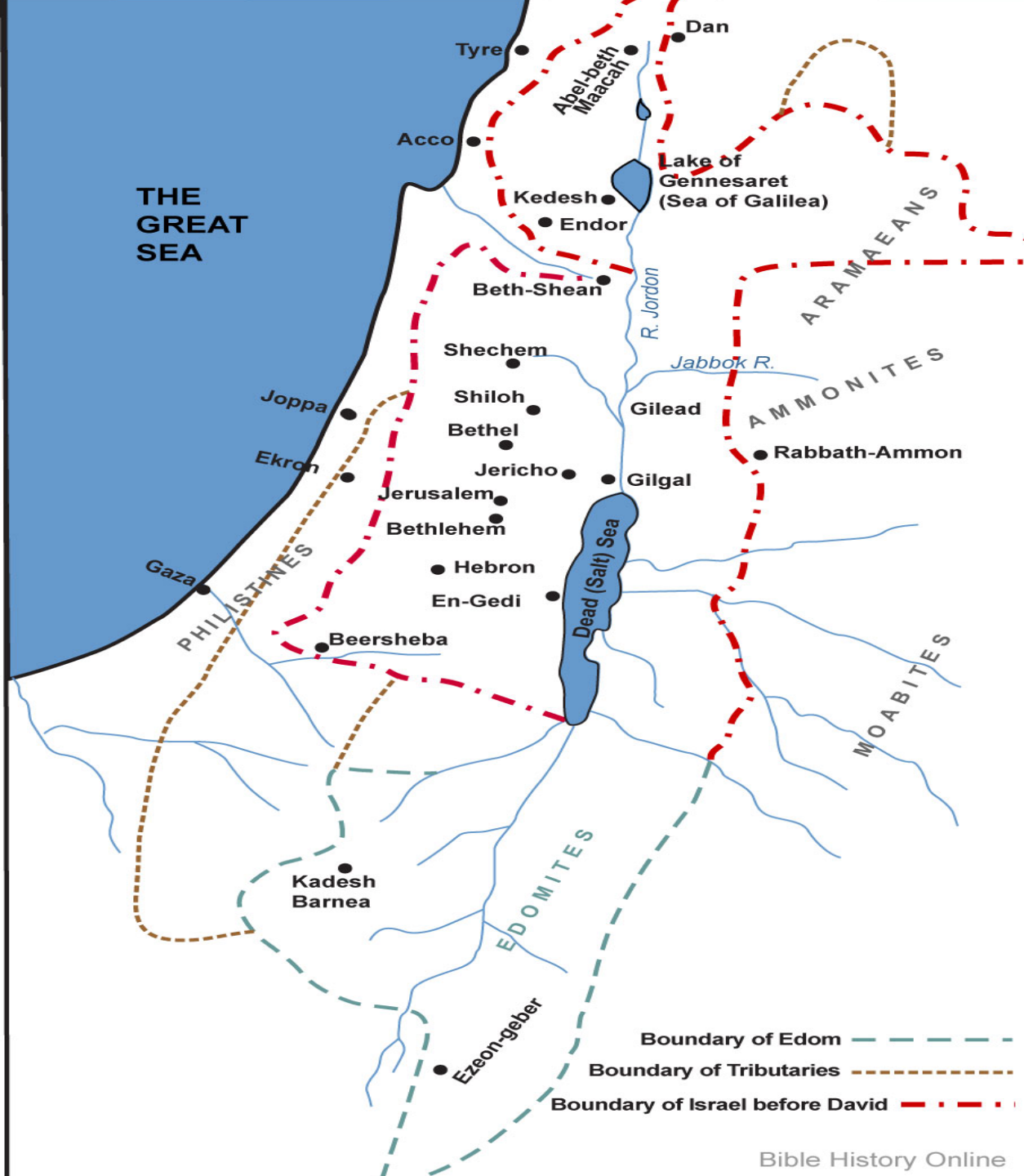

2 Samuel, 1 Kings 1-11—*United Kingdoms of David and Solomon*

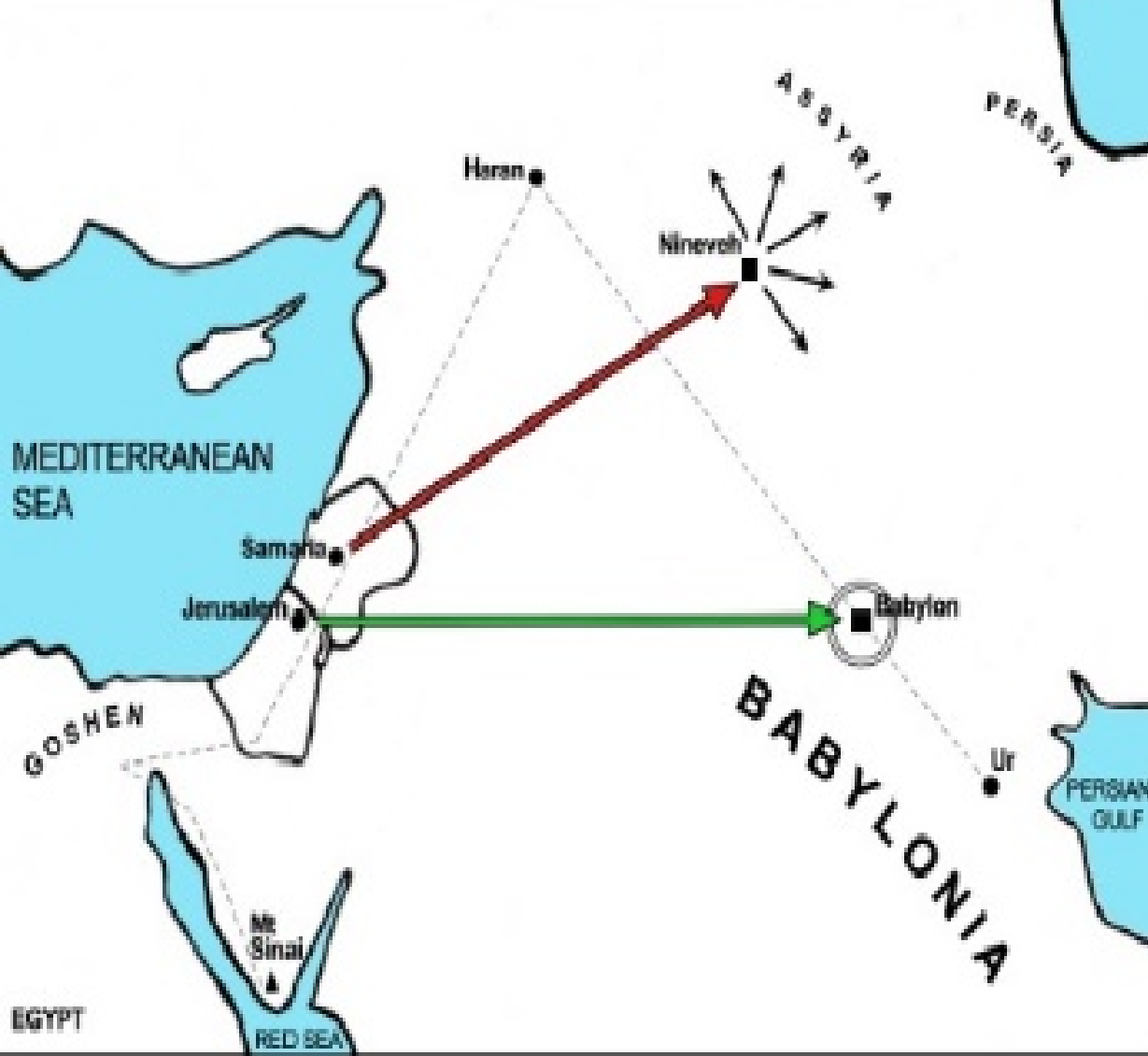
(2 Samuel repeats united Israel)

- ◆ **King David *united*** Israel, Jerusalem became worship center 2 Sam. 1-7
- ◆ David defeats Philistia and other nations ch. 8-10
- ◆ David's sins brought trouble and ***division*** to Israel ch. 11-24
- ◆ **Solomon** became king 1 Kings 1-4
- ◆ He built the Temple, restored the Ark and Covenant ch. 5-6
- ◆ Solomon disobeyed God and ***Israel declined*** ch. 11



1 Kings 12-2 Kings—*Division and Exile*

- ◆ Solomon’s son **Rehoboam** was named king. He threatened forced labor.
The North revolted, **Jeroboam** became King of Israel’s Northern tribes, and King Rehoboam over Judah (South). ch. 12
- ◆ King Jeroboam and his **18 successor kings** “*all did evil in the sight of the Lord.*”
2 Kings 17
- ◆ Assyria invaded and exiled Israel in 722 B.C.
- ◆ Rehoboam’s **19 successor kings** included 8 who followed God, and **12** who “*did evil in the sight of the Lord.*”
- ◆ Judah was exiled to Babylon in 586 B.C.
2 Kings 23



2 Kings, 2 Chron.—*Decline and Exiles to Assyria and Babylon*

- ◆ Assyria invaded and exiled **Israel** in 722 B.C. 2 Kings 17
- ◆ **Judah** was exiled to Babylon in 586 B.C. 2 Kings 23

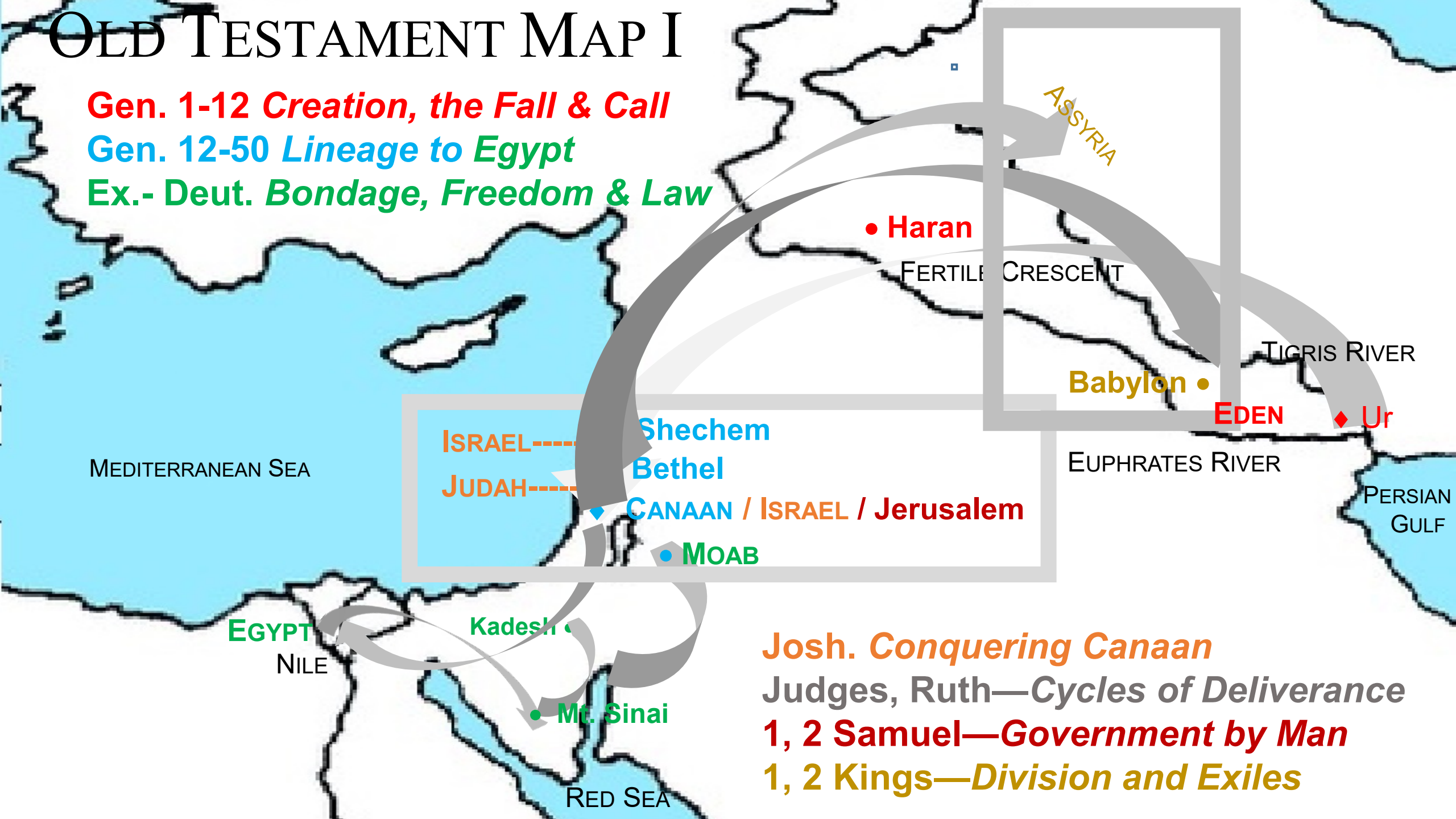
- KEY:
- From Ur to Mount Sinai
 - People of Northern Kingdom (Israel) taken to Assyria and dispersed
 - People of Southern Kingdom (Judah) taken to Babylon

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

1. **Solomon—united Israel and built the Temple, but failed God.**

1 Kings 1-11, 2 Chron. 1-9

- a. **Solomon became king**, rose to glory, (1 Kings 1-4), and **constructed** the Temple (Ch. 5-6).
- b. **The Ark returned** and the **Covenant was retold** (Ch. 8-9). **Solomon disobeyed** and **Israel declined** (Ch. 11).
- c. The Temple was **finished** (2 Chron. 1-7). **Solomon knew God's plan** but **failed** and died (Ch. 7-9).

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

KEY VERSES

*“And as for you, **if you will walk before me, as David your father walked, with integrity of heart and uprightness, doing according to all that I have commanded you, and keeping my statutes and my rules, then I will establish your royal throne over Israel forever, as I promised David your father, saying, ‘You shall not lack a man on the throne of Israel,’**” ... “Therefore **the Lord said to Solomon, ‘Since this has been your practice and you have not kept my covenant and my statutes that I have commanded you, I will surely tear the kingdom from you and will give it to your servant,’**” ... **“if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land,”** 1 Kings 9:4-5 ... 11:11 ... 2 Chron. 7:14*

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

- 2. Divided Kingdom—the north, called “Israel,” declined. It was exiled by 722 B.C. 1 Kings 12- 2 Kings 17**
- a. Solomon’s son **Rehoboam** threatened his “yoke on Israel,” the **North revolted**, and the **Kingdom divided** (1 Kings 12).
 - b. King **Jeroboam**, and **18 successors**, all “**did evil in God’s sight**,” and **gross idolatry** followed.
 - c. **God sent Prophet Elijah** and others to warn His people (1 Kings 17), but **Israel to the north sinned and fell to exile** (2 Kings 17).

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

KEY VERSES

“The people of Israel walked in all the sins that Jeroboam did. They did not depart from them, until the Lord removed Israel out of his sight, as he had spoken by all his servants the prophets. So Israel was exiled from their own land to Assyria until this day,” 2 Kings 17:22-23

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

3. Southern Kingdom of **Judah**—**declined** and was **exiled** in **586 B.C.**
2 Kings 18-25, 2 Chron. 10-36
 - a. **Eight of Judah's 20 kings followed God** like David, but **12 “did evil in God's sight.”**
 - b. **God sent prophets** Obadiah, Joel, Isaiah, Micah, Jeremiah, etc., with warnings to Judah.
 - c. **After Israel was exiled** Hezekiah and 7 others reigned over Judah until the southern **Judah** area was **exiled to Babylon** (2 Kings 24).

GOVERNMENTS OF GOD AND MAN

KEY VERSES

*“The Lord, the **God** of their fathers, **sent persistently** to them **by his messengers**, because **he had compassion on his people and on his dwelling place**. But they **kept mocking the messengers of God**, despising his words and **scoffing at his prophets**, until the **wrath of the Lord rose against his people**, until there was no **remedy**,”... “And the Lord said, “**I will remove Judah also out of my sight, as I have removed Israel, and I will cast off this city that I have chosen, Jerusalem, and the house of which I said, My name shall be there,**” 2 Chron. 36:15-16
... 2 Kings 23:27*
