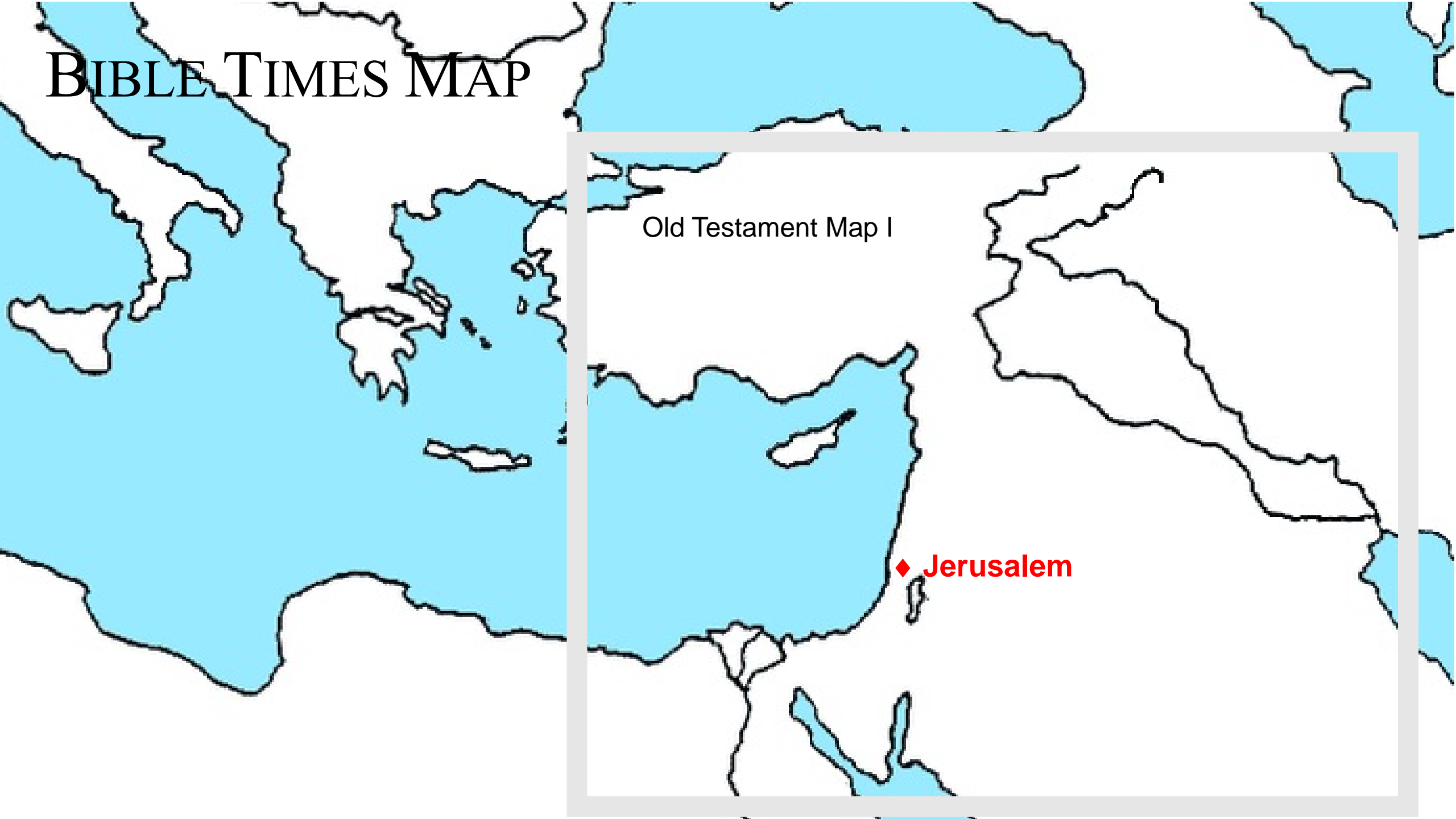

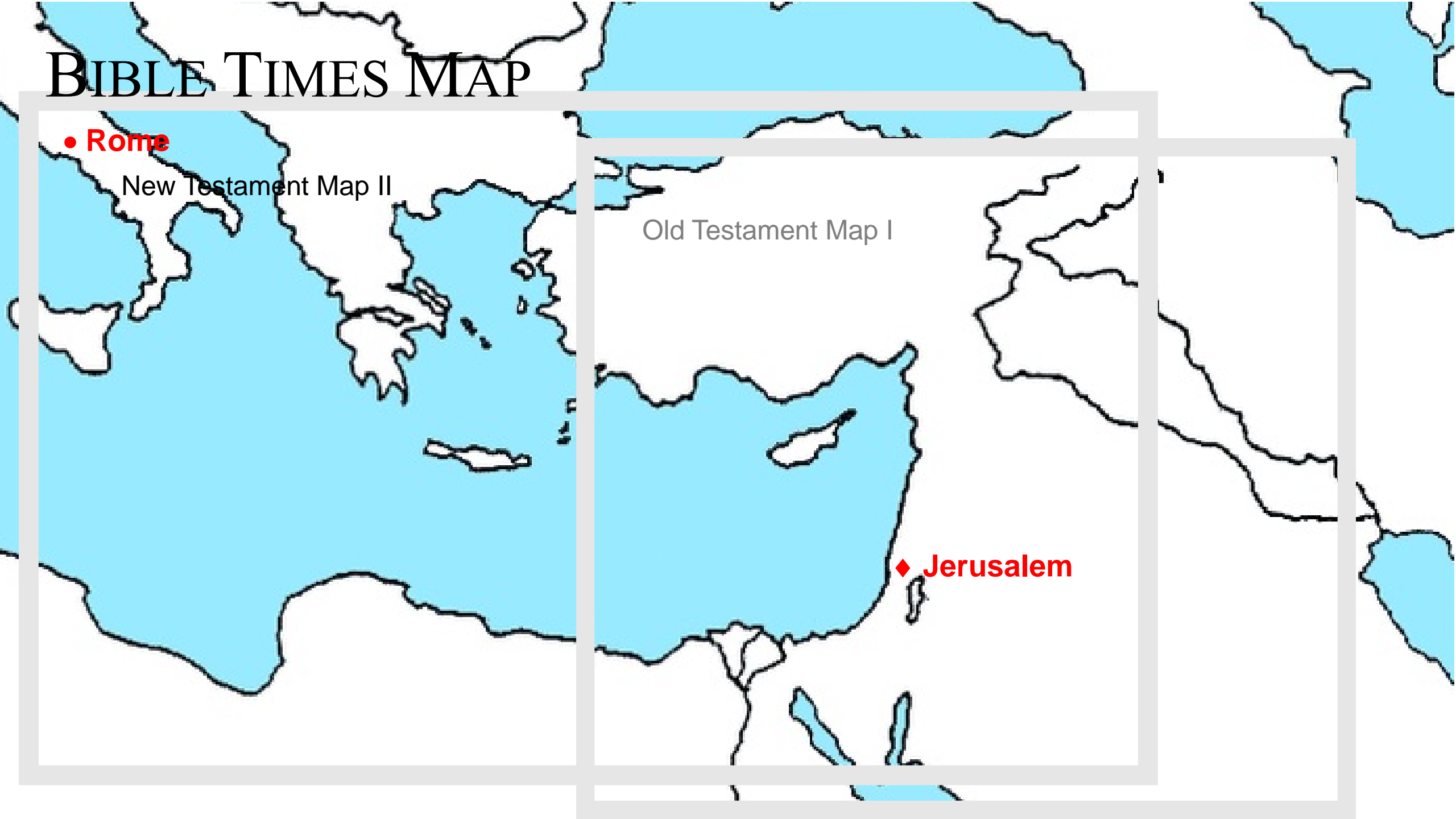

## Exodus—*Bondage, Freedom & Law*

- ◆ In Egyptian bondage 1875 B.C.-1445 B.C. ch. 1-13
- ◆ Crossed the Red Sea 1445 B.C. ch. 14
- ◆ Preserved in wilderness 2 months ch. 15-18
- ◆ Receive Law at Mt. Sinai 10 months ch. 19-40

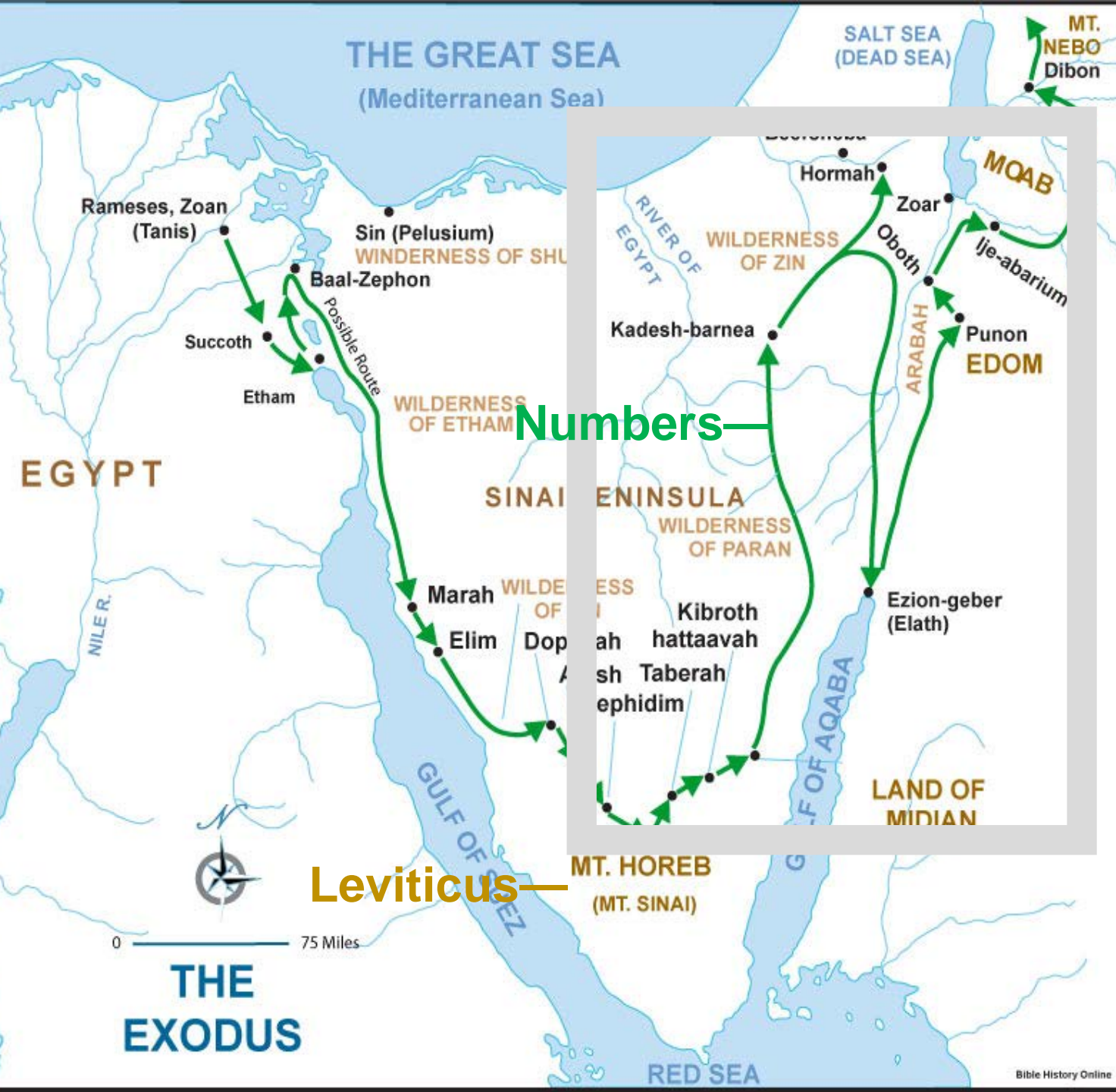


## Exodus—*Bondage, Freedom & Law*

- ◆ In Egyptian bondage 1875 B.C.-1445 B.C. ch. 1-13
- ◆ Crossed the Red Sea 1445 B.C. ch. 14
- ◆ Preserved in wilderness 2 months ch. 15-18
- ◆ Receive Law at Mt. Sinai ch. 19-40  
10 months

## Leviticus—*Sin, Sacrifice and Holiness*

- ◆ No geographical movement happens during Leviticus, 1 month in 1445 B.C.
- ◆ The Israelites are camped at the foot of Mt. Horeb (also called Mt. Sinai).



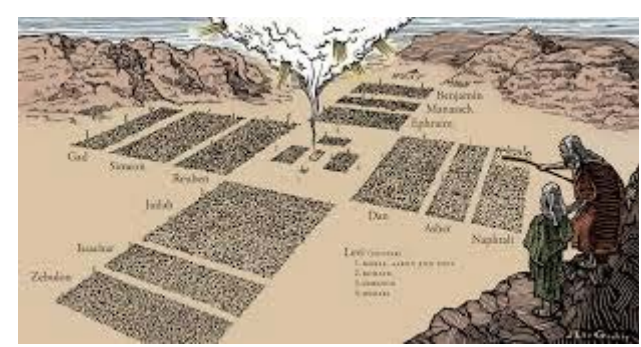

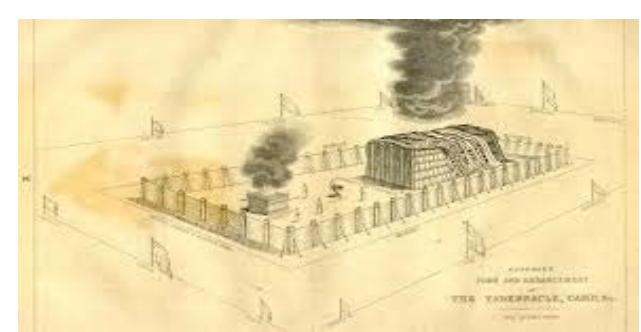

## Numbers—Trials and Testing

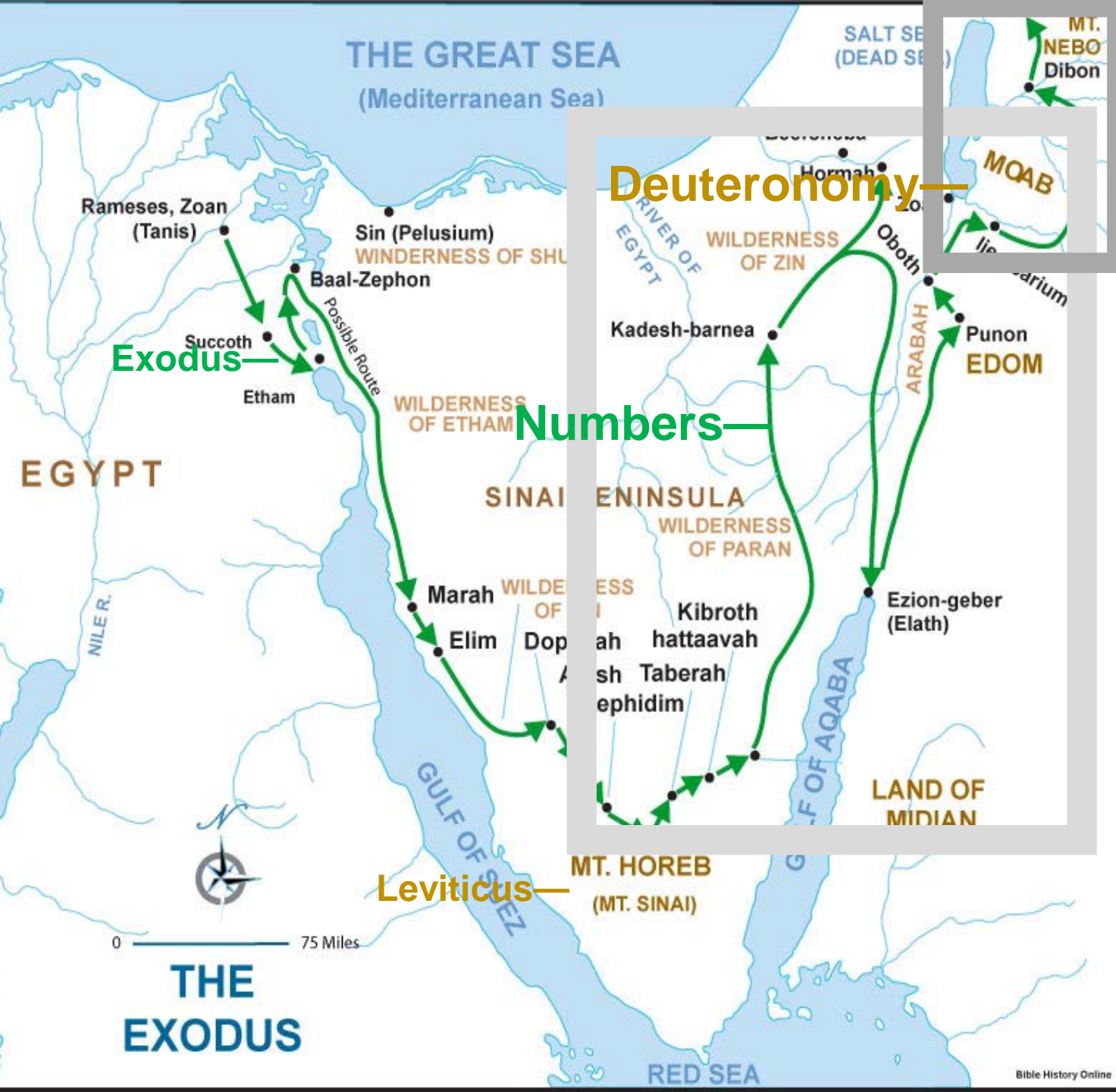
- ◆ Organized and sanctified the generations of Israel ch. 1-10  
1 month in 1445 B.C.
- ◆ Strengthened and tested them from Kadesh to Moab ch. 10-25  
1445 to 1405 B.C.
- ◆ Prepared the new generation on the Plains of Moab ch. 26-36  
5 months 1405 B.C.

# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

1. **God had called Israel and delivered it from bondage.** Deut. 1-4
  - a. God commanded Israel to **leave Moab and go to Canaan to possess the land** (Ch. 1:1-5).
  - b. Through the wilderness, **God had led Israel to defeat the Kings of Sihon and Og** (Ch. 1:6-3:20).
  - c. **Moses himself was forbidden to enter** (Ch. 3) and **commanded obedience to God alone** (Ch. 4).

# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

## KEY VERSES

*“And now, O Israel, **listen to the statutes and the rules that I am teaching you, and do them, that you may live, and go in and take possession of the land that the Lord, the God of your fathers, is giving you.**” ... **“Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, ‘Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.’ For what great nation is there that has a god so near to it as the Lord our God is to us, whenever we call upon him? And what great nation is there, that has statutes and rules so righteous as all this law that I set before you today?”** Deut. 4:1 ... 6-8*

# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

2. God expected Israel to **be moral and holy to Him.**

Deut. 4-26

- a. Moses **repeated the Law** in relation to Israel's **Covenant with God** (Ch. 4-5).
- b. Moses urged Israel's **fear of the Lord** in **keeping and teaching the laws and statutes** (Ch. 6-11).
- c. Moses taught additional **ceremonial, civil and social laws** (Ch. 12-26).



# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

## KEY VERSES

***“And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the commandments and statutes of the Lord, which I am commanding you today for your good,” Deut. 10:12-13***

# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

## 3. **God brought Israel into His Holy Land.**

Deut. 27-34

- a. Israel was commanded to **ratify its Covenant with God** once in **Canaan** (Ch. 27-28).
- b. The Israelites were **told and warned** that their **Covenant is with God** (Ch. 29-30).
- c. Moses charged **Joshua to lead Israel**, and **died on Mt. Nebo** (Ch. 31-34).

# DISCIPLINE AND OBEDIENCE

## KEY VERSES

***“I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore **choose life**, that you and your offspring may **live, loving the Lord your God**, obeying his voice and **holding fast** to him, for **he is your life and length of days**, that **you may dwell in the land** that the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, **to give them,**” Deut. 30:19-20***
