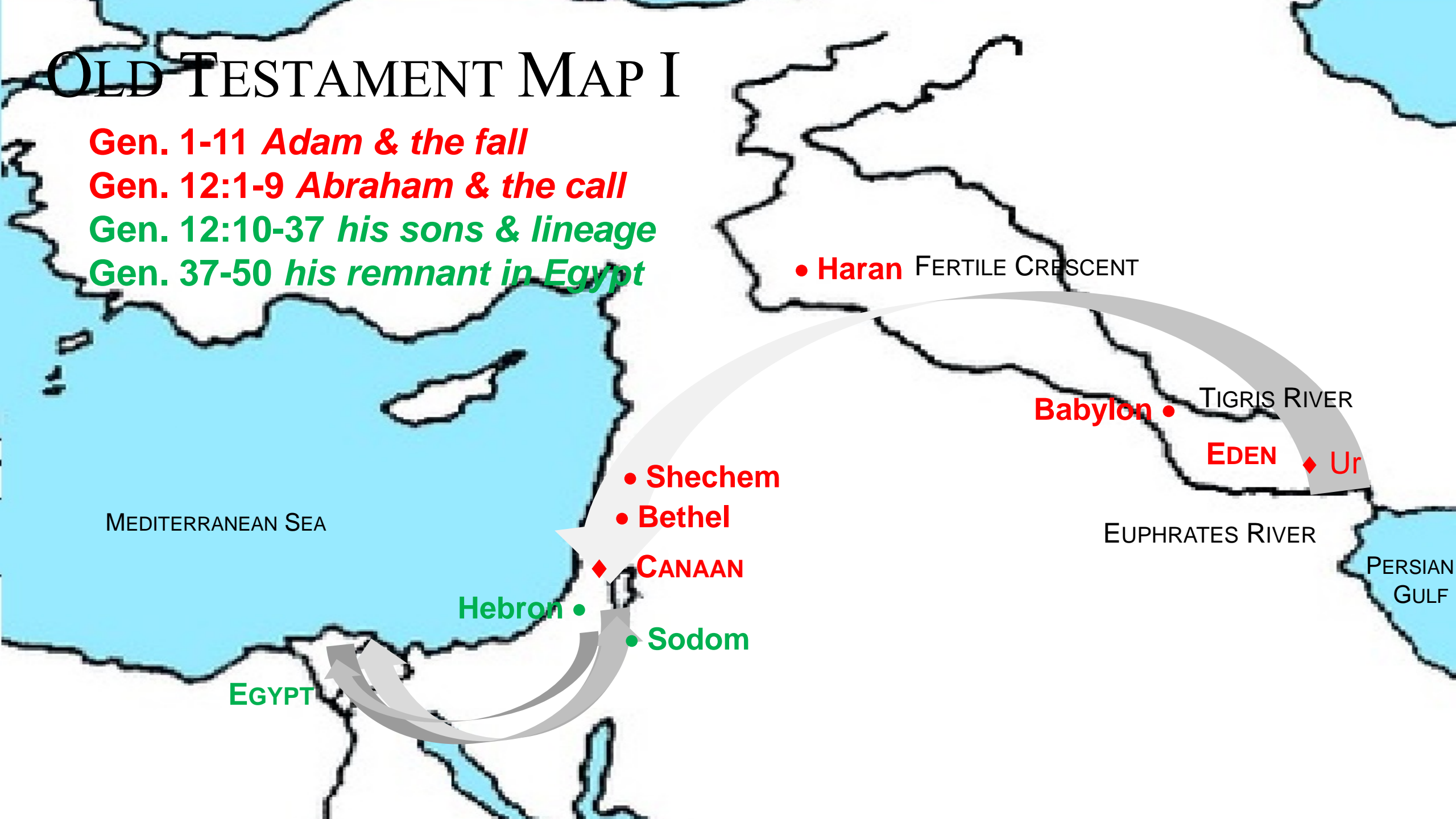

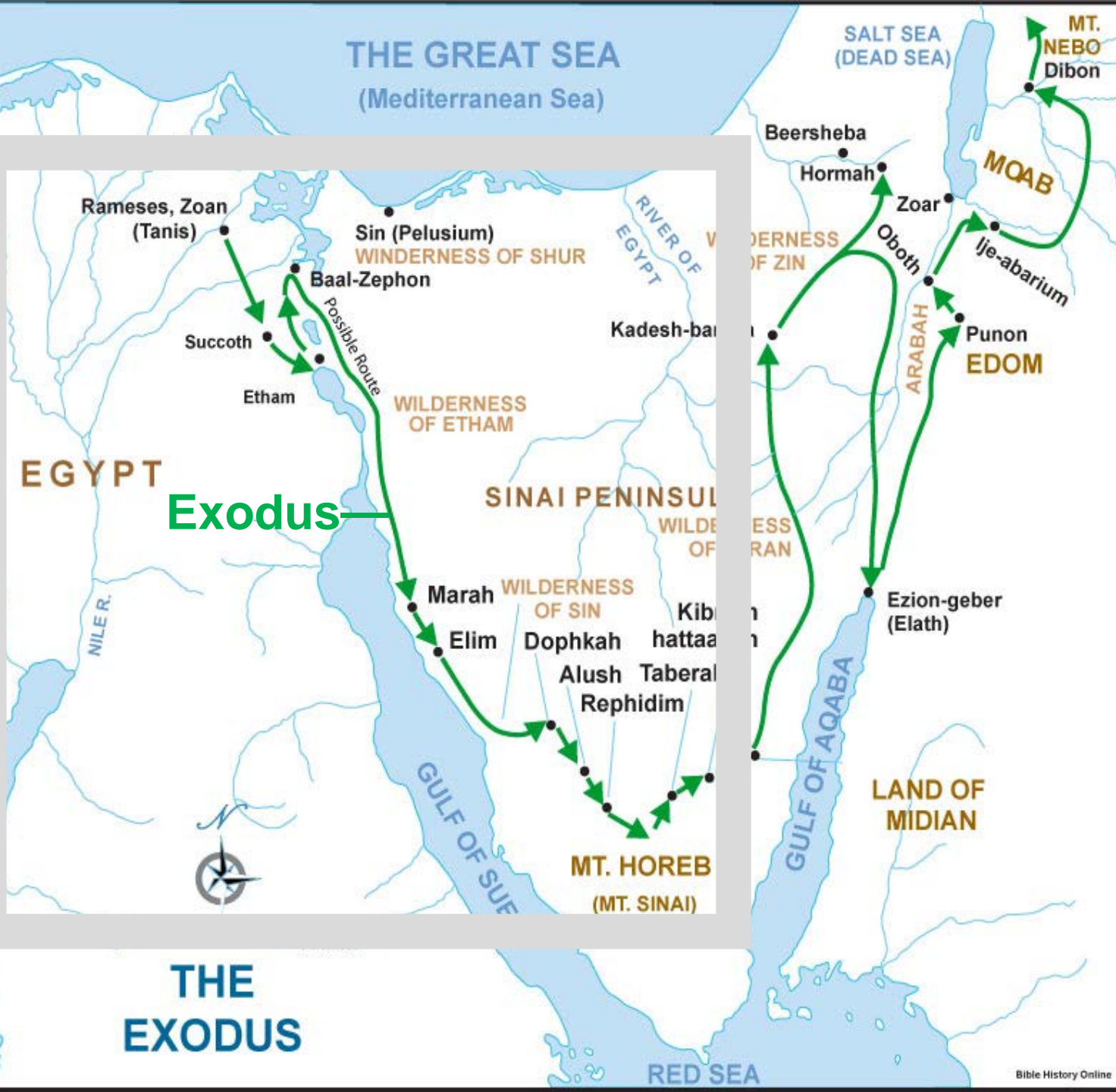

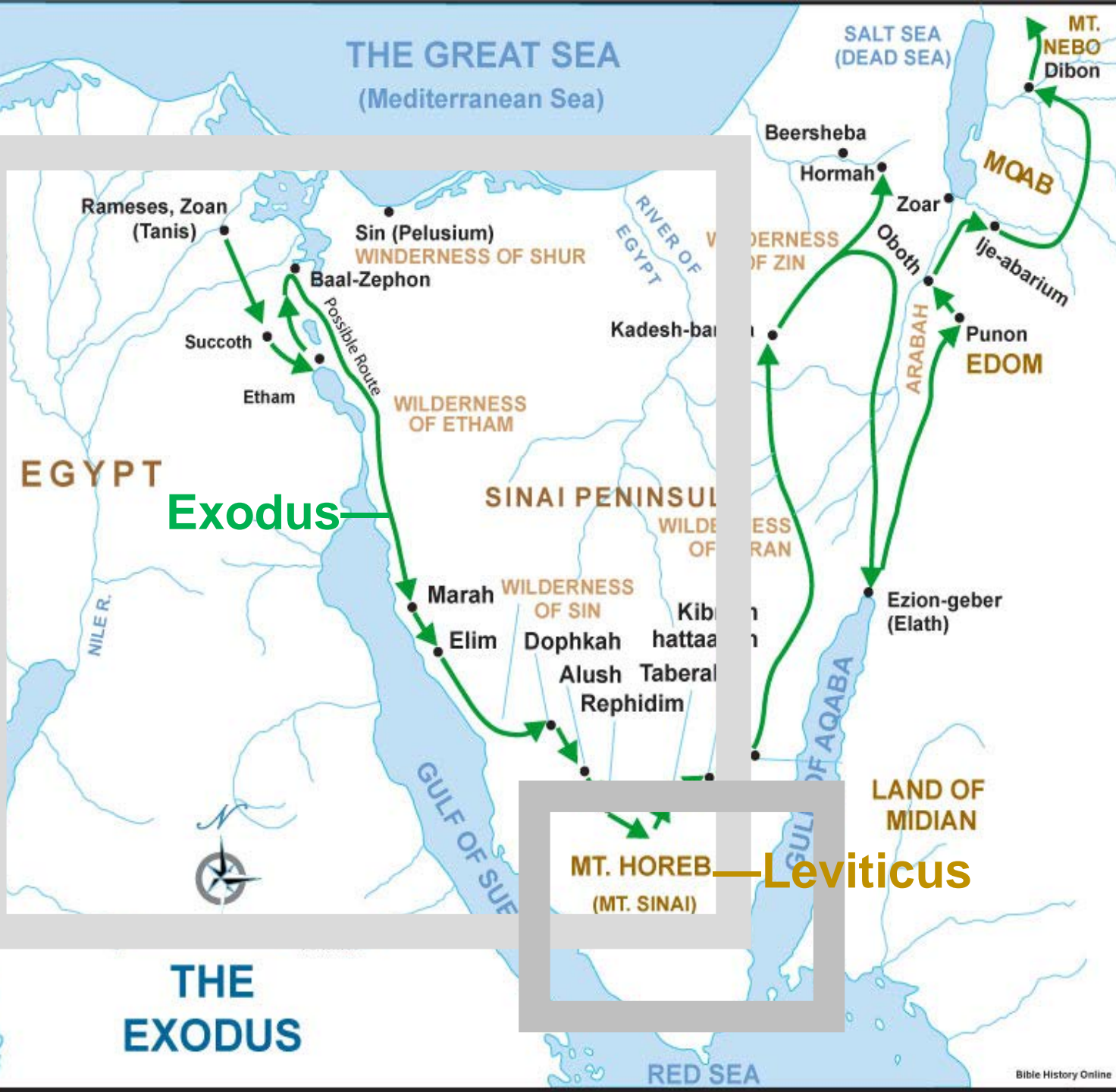

Exodus—*Bondage, Freedom & Law*

- ◆ In Egyptian bondage 1875 B.C.-1445 B.C. ch. 1-13
- ◆ Crossed the Red Sea 1445 B.C. ch. 14
- ◆ Preserved in wilderness 2 months ch. 15-18
- ◆ Receive Law at Mt. Sinai 10 months ch. 19-40

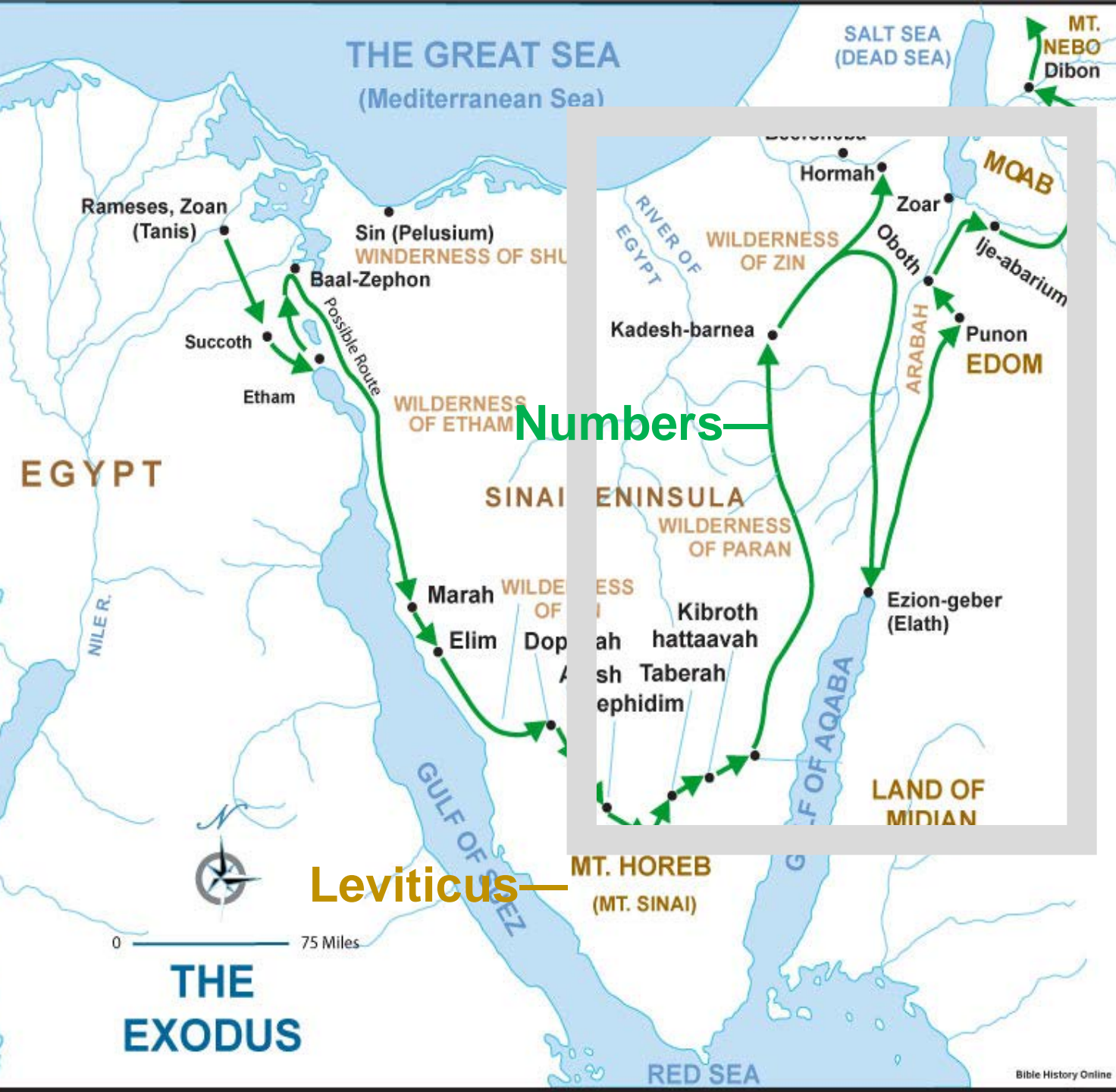


Exodus—*Bondage, Freedom & Law*

- ◆ In Egyptian bondage 1875 B.C.-1445 B.C. ch. 1-13
- ◆ Crossed the Red Sea 1445 B.C. ch. 14
- ◆ Preserved in wilderness 2 months ch. 15-18
- ◆ Receive Law at Mt. Sinai ch. 19-40
10 months

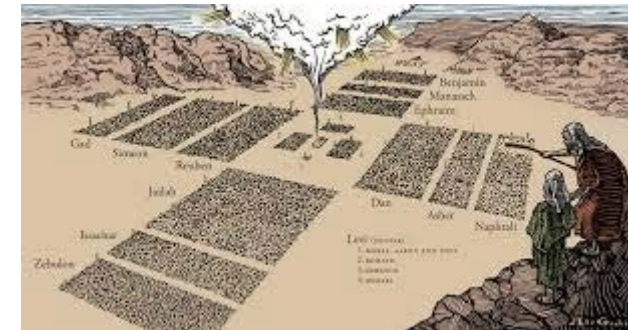
Leviticus—*Sin, Sacrifice and Holiness*

- ◆ No geographical movement happens during Leviticus, 1 month in 1445 B.C.
- ◆ The Israelites are camped at the foot of Mt. Horeb (also called Mt. Sinai).

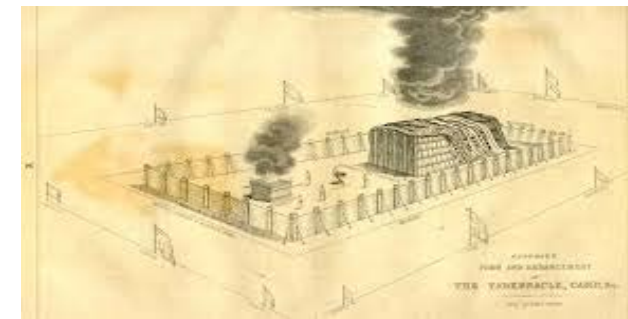


Numbers—Trials and Testing

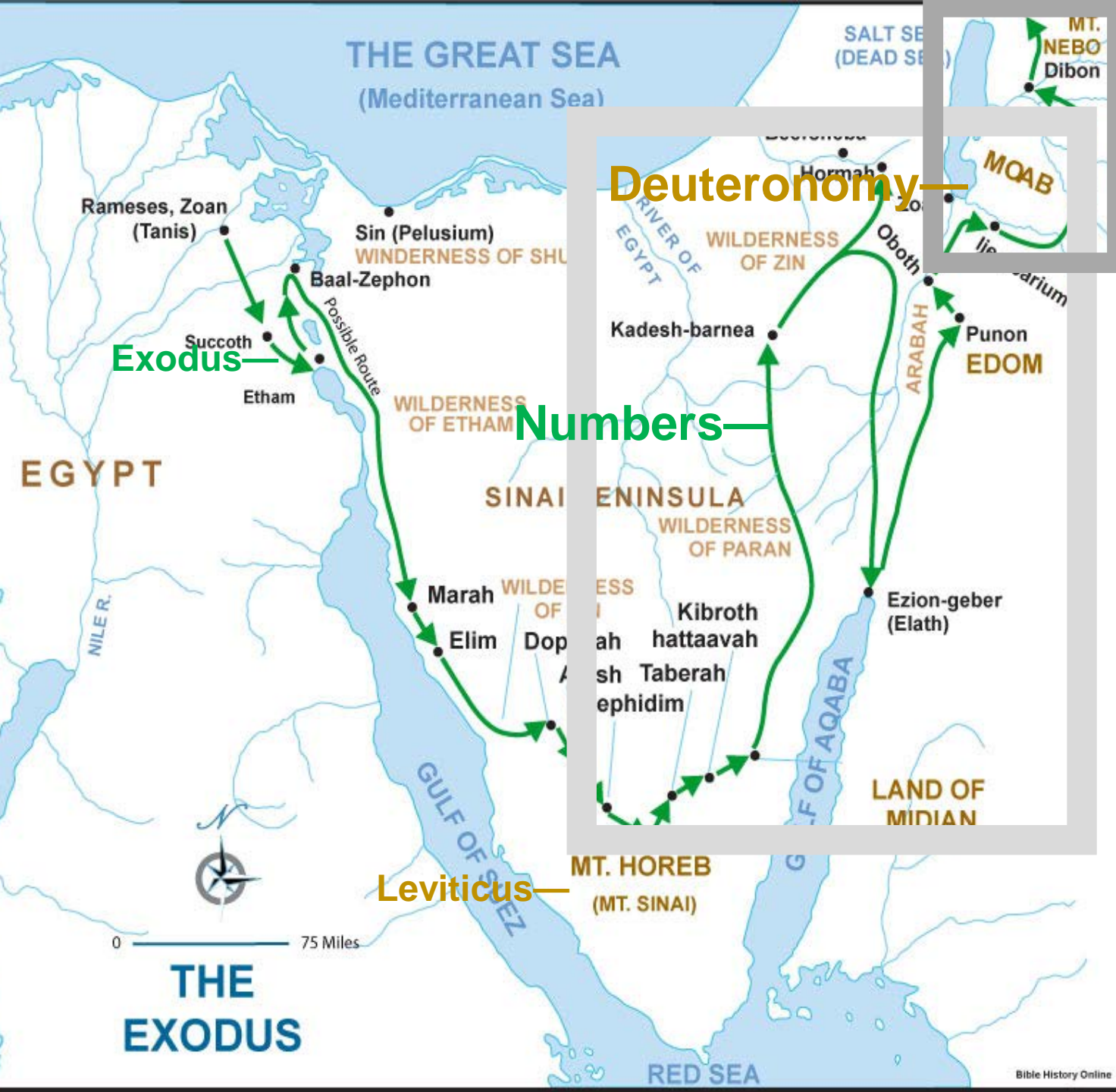
- ◆ Organized and sanctified the generations of Israel
ch. 1-10
1 month in 1445 B.C.
- ◆ Strengthened and tested them from Kadesh to Moab
ch. 10-25
1445 to 1405 B.C.
- ◆ Prepared the new generation on the Plains of Moab
ch. 26-36
5 months 1405 B.C.

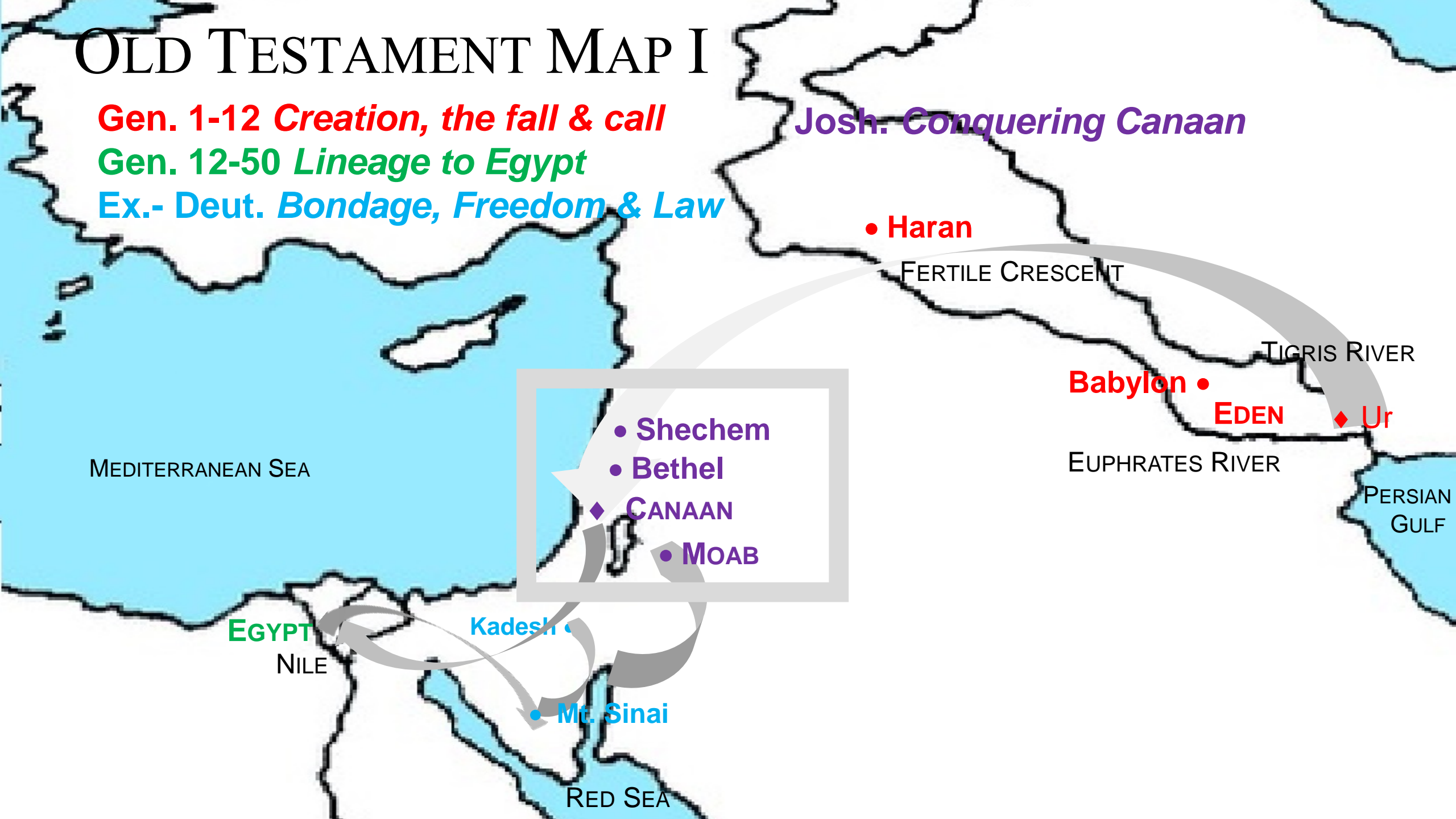

- ◆ Jericho victory ch. 6
- ◆ Ai defeat ch. 7
- ◆ Ai victory ch. 8
- ◆ Gibeonite failure ch. 9
- ◆ Amorite victory over 5 kings at Makkedah and areas South ch. 10
- ◆ Northern victory from Bethel to Hazor ch. 11
- ◆ In all—31 kings defeated by Joshua ch. 12:23
- ◆ Philistines and Gaza not conquered ch. 13
- ◆ Allotments of land ch. 13-19
- ◆ Cities of Refuge, Levites, and conditions ch. 20-24

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

1. Preparing for Conquests—and to Follow God.

Josh. 1-5

- a. **God commissioned Joshua** leader, and he **commanded tribes East and West** of Jordan (Ch. 1).
- b. Joshua sent **spies to Jericho** who **met Rahab** (Ch. 2), and **led Israel across** the Jordan (Ch. 3-4).
- c. **Joshua led Israel spiritually** under God with **circumcision and Passover** (Ch. 5).

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

KEY VERSES

“This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go,” Josh. 1:8-9

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

2. Conquering Canaan—and Sin and Evil.

Josh. 6-13:7

- a. **God led Israel's Jericho victory and saved Rahab (Ch. 6), but Achan's sin led defeat at Ai (Ch. 7).**
- b. **God purified Israel and led victory at Ai. Israel worshiped God in response (Ch. 8).**
- c. **Israel conquered Southern Canaan (Ch. 9-10), and Northern Canaan (Ch. 11) and kings (Ch. 12-13).**

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

KEY VERSES

“So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the Lord had spoken to Moses. And Joshua gave it for an inheritance to Israel according to their tribal allotments. And the land had rest from war,” Josh. 11:23

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

3. **Settling in Canaan—a Promised Land.**

Josh. 13:8-24

- a. **Israel's allotted lands were settled East of the Jordan** (Ch. 13).
- b. **Allotted lands were settled West** of the Jordan (Ch. 14-19).
- c. **Religious settlements** and conditions were **laid out**; Joshua and Eleazar died (Ch. 20-24).

CONQUERING AND CONQUESTS

KEY VERSES

*“And the people said to Joshua, ‘**The Lord our God we will serve, and his voice we will obey.**’ So Joshua made a **covenant with the people that day, and put in place statutes and rules for them at Shechem,**” Josh. 24:24-25*
